BENEFITS AND PRIVILEGES:

- ✦ **A well-rounded education: academics, leadership, teamwork, and physical fitness — for free.**

The President of the Philippines approves and signs the appointments as cadets of qualified applicants – that practically awards to deserving applicants an all-expense paid education.

The government spends for a cadet's four-year education and training at a per capita cost of P2 million each. The PMA provides practically everything that cadets would need during their stay in the Academy. From the 18 sets of uniform they wear; to school supplies they use; from educational and training facilities to board and lodging; from post concessionaires that cater to other particular needs to hospital and dental facilities; to modern living, dining, and recreational amenities.

During their entire 4 years of training, cadets get to experience to fire selected armaments in the AFP arsenal, tour key cities of the Philippines and selected countries in Asia and, for selected deserving cadets, a chance to travel to foreign countries. They train with their respective branches of service just before they graduate to assimilate the practices, customs, and traditions of their chosen branch of service.

- ✦ **Receive salary and allowances while studying**

PMA cadets receive a gross pay of P14, 448.00.

- ✦ **Guaranteed job after graduation**

Immediately after graduation from the Academy, cadets are directly commissioned as regular officers in the Armed Forces of the Philippines, joining any of the three branches of service of their choice. They at once assume the role of direct leaders in the field as Platoon Commanders for the Army and Marine 2nd Lieutenants and Mess and Supply Officers for Navy Ensigns. For the Air Force 2nd Lieutenants, they report immediately to the Philippine Air Force Flying School for Pilot Training. Hence, PMAers get ready employment.

- ✦ **Progressive career as an officer in the Philippine Army, Navy, or Air Force**

PMA education encompasses different aspects of learning: hence, geared towards the development of a well-rounded officer and leader. It prepares the cadet to become, not only as a soldier and a leader of character while in the service, but also as a productive citizen essential to nation building.

- ✦ **The rare privilege to serve the Motherland**

After four years of challenges and sacrifices, the door opens the opportunities for these young leaders to be of service to God, Country, and the Filipino people. The AFP takes responsibility in keeping the State safe and the National sovereignty secured in war or in peace. As such, AFP members commit themselves to a dedicated service to the nation.
